2022 VOTING CHECK-UP FOR BOLIVAR COUNTY CITIZENS

Getting Bolivar County Voters ready for the upcoming 2022 Primaries and Elections. Here are some common voter questions and issues that occur during election season:

- ✓ Are you registered to vote?
 - Make sure that you are registered to vote at least 30 days prior to every election.
- ✓ If you are recently registered, ensure that you have received confirmation or your Voter Registration Card.
 - o If you have not received your VRC, please contact the Circuit Clerk's Office.
- ✓ If you have moved since the last election, please, please UPDATE your registration prior to the next election by visiting the Circuit Clerk's Office or contacting your election commissioner.
- ✓ If you are a college student or know someone who is a college student living on campus, ensure that the student uses his/her correct physical address.
 - If you wish to vote in Bolivar County elections, you MUST use your Bolivar County address to be eligible.
- ✓ When voting in person (at the polls or in-person absentee), always ensure that you
 have your Voter ID
- ✓ Get familiar with your Voting Precinct; Bolivar County has 28 precincts.
 - If you are not sure where you should vote, please contact the Circuit Clerk's Office.
